

SWISH SECURE

Windows and doors are the first line of defense in protecting your home from burglary. All Swish windows and doors are fitted with high security multipoint locking and designed with clever features to thwart the most determined burglar. Here are some practical ways to protect your home from intruders and advice on how to make sure your new windows or doors are high security.

LOCK IT	It may sound obvious but lock your doors and windows every time you leave the house, even when you're just out in the garden. Keep doors locked even when you're in and secure all external doors and downstairs or vulnerable windows at night.
STOP LOCK SNAPPING	Burglars often attack doors by 'snapping' or breaking the lock. Make sure your new front or back door is fitted with a high security anti-snap, anti-bump lock. Your local Swish Authorised Installer can demonstrate the latest in high security doors.
BACK DOORS ARE THE MOST VULNERABLE	Out of sight back and side doors are often most vulnerable so make sure they are strong and fitted with high security locks.
HIDE YOUR KEYS	Including car keys, keep them out of sight and away from the letterbox. Burglars can use a stick or rod to hook keys through the letterbox.
FIT A SPY HOLE IN YOUR NEW FRONT DOOR	It's important to be cautious when you're at home and a spy hole lets you safely check who is calling.
FIT A HIGH QUALITY DOOR CHAIN	This will help you maintain security even when you're answering the door to unexpected visitors.
MAKE IT HARDER	Keep ladders and tools stored away; don't leave them outside where they could be used to break into your home. Keep side gates are locked to prevent access to the rear of the property.
CHOOSE HIGH SECURITY LOCKS	Make sure your new windows are fitted with multi-point locks tested to the stringent BS7950 Standard. Also choose windows with internal beads to prevent the glass unit from being tampered with.
KEEP THE LIGHTS ON	Leave radios or lights in your house on a timer to make the property appear occupied.
